
Find the flowers

Allium Moly

Long green leaves and star-shaped, yellow flowers with 6 petals

Season: early summer

Dianthus Cruentus

Tall stems topped with clusters of red-pink flowers

Season: spring/summer

Narcissus Poeticus Recurvus

Wide, star-shaped, bright white flowers with small, red-lined yellow cup at the centre

Season: late spring Se

Calamintha 'Blue Cloud'

Mounds of green covered in small, soft blue flowers

Season: summer/autumn

Allium
Sphaerocephalon

Egg-shaped heads of green and maroon flowers on tall, leafless stems

Season: summer
